

**CALL FOR PROPOSALS FOR THE AWARD OF RESEARCH STUDENTSHIPS WITHIN THE
FRAMEWORK OF R&D PROJECTS AND INSTITUTIONS**

Research Studentships for Master or Integrated Master degree students

Applications are open for 1 (ONE) Research Studentship, within the framework of project TEPE – “Technologically Expanded Performance” (PTDC/ART-PER/31263/2017), financed by national funds through FCT, under the following conditions:

Scientific Area: Artistic Studies, Media Studies or Cultural Management

Admission Requirements:

According to Article 6 of FCT Regulation for Research Studentships and Fellowships (Reg. nr. 950/2019):

- *Hold a degree in the Arts, or in Social Sciences and Humanities, or in Communication, or in Management, by the date of submission of the application;*
- *Be enrolled in a study cycle leading to a Master's degree;*
- *Have proven experience in artistic projects and/or have belonged to teams that organize artistic and/or scientific dissemination events.*

Academic degrees obtained in foreign countries shall be registered by a Portuguese institution, according to the Decree-Law nr. 66/2018, of August, 16th, and the Ordinance nr. 33/2019, of January, 25th. Workplan:

To follow the activities related to the Research Project "TEPE - Technologically Expanded Performance", namely by participating in the work meetings, collaborating in the organization of the International Meeting and in the organization of associated documentation.

To contribute to the development of research activities, document collection and organization, and editorial production, in the context of the finalization of the TEPE project.

To contribute to the establishment of research networks, from the deepening of the interactions between science and art.

Workplace: The work will be developed at Instituto de Etnomusicologia – centro de estudos em música e dança (INET-md) of Faculdade de Motricidade Humana, under the scientific supervision of Professor Daniel Tércio.

Duration: The research fellowship will have the duration of 3 (THREE) months. It is expected to begin in 1st of February of 2022 and may be eventually renewed for one-month periods.

Monthly maintenance allowance: According to the values for Research Fellowships awarded by FCT in Portugal (<http://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores>), the amount of the monthly maintenance allowance is € 835,98, being Wire Transfer the payment method.

Selection methods: The selection methods will be the following: *Curriculum evaluation*.

All admitted applications must be graded from zero (0.00, minimum) to twenty (20.00, maximum) in each of the evaluation criteria:

Criterion A - Academic qualifications (Bachelor's Degree) - 40%

Criterion B - Academic and professional background - 40%

Criterion C - Motivation Letter - 20%.

Announcement/ notification of the results: The final evaluation results will be communicated to all applicants by email.

Application deadline and formalization: The call is open from December 20th, 2021 until January 10th, 2022.

It is mandatory to formalize applications with the submission of the following documents: i) Application Form; ii) *Curriculum Vitae*; iii) academic degree certificate, where applicable; iv) proof of enrollment at



an academic degree course (Master, Integrated Master) or at a course that does not award an academic degree; v) motivation letter; vi) (for holders of Bachelor or Master degrees who are enrolled at a course that does not award an academic degree) declaration on honour that the applicant does not exceed with this contract an accumulated period of two years in this type of studentship, continuously or with interruptions.
